

# Two New Gallery Exhibits At Cotuit Center For Arts

Two gallery exhibits are featured at the Cotuit Center for the Arts: "TRANSFORMATIONS: Mixed Media Digital Printmaking" by ArtSynergies and "Into Color: Watercolor Reliefs and Drawings" by Bob Enos. Both will run through May 23.

Mary Doering, Barbara Ford Doyle, and Martine Jore of ArtSynergies embrace mixed-media and an array of digital tools. The exhibit includes photography, alternative image-making processes, and experimental printing techniques. Their photographic images have been disassembled, reconstructed, and transfer-printed onto various intriguing substrates

ArtSynergies will also conduct a free workshop, "The Art of Digital Printmaking" tomorrow from 2 to 4 PM.

"Struggle" is the word that best characterizes Bob Enos's approach to making art. He is constantly pulling away from formal art training, struggling to identify familiar and comfortable ways of solving visual problems. If he is not surprised by a work he has just finished, then Mr. Enos is not pleased by it either.

The prints and drawings in this exhibit are from one of Mr. Enos's earlier periods when he was primarily a printmaker. Works from this period were shown in galleries and exhibitions and are now in many private and corporate collections.

The colored-pencil still-life works and the watercolor reliefs are more recent works and more abstract. Abstraction has allowed Mr. Enos greater freedom for invention and a bolder use of color.
