

A Tribute To Bob Dylan

Art Tebbetts and Matt Borrello, two friends and musicians who love Bob Dylan, will celebrate Dylan's 70th birthday with a Dylan Tribute Concert tomorrow night at 7 at the Third Fret Coffeehouse at the Cotuit Center for the Arts.

Both Mr. Tebbetts and Mr. Borrello have some 60 Dylan songs in their repertoire.

Mr. Tebbetts and Mr. Borrello met when Mr. Tebbetts was teaching an after-school class for high schoolers at the University of Massachusetts in Dartmouth several years ago.

"Matt walks into class... wearing denim pants and jacket over a blue work shirt," said Mr. Tebbetts. "The cap was a nice touch, too. He pulled out his guitar and launched into Dylan songs and I knew this kid had it!"

Mr. Borrello has grown as a performer and singer/songwriter. Several years ago, he was a finalist in the Boston Folk Festival's Young Songwriter's competition (finishing second to his sister

Sarah). He has been playing solo and with his band throughout the state. Though his repertoire has grown, he is still a fan of Bob Dylan.

Mr. Tebbetts enjoys folk music and has always loved Bob Dylan and his songs.

"I host an Open Mic in New Bedford, and every year just before Dylan's birthday, we hold 'a bash.' I am always amazed that so many different performers all have some Dylan in their collection of songs. It always makes for a terrific night."

This is the second year that the two friends have done a Dylan Birthday Bash as a way of sharing their love of Bob Dylan with others.
